

Webmaster Report for Committee Meeting 30th March 2025

Website

I am concerned that I have only had one local group provide additional information for their listing since my last report (and only 5 in total) and no submissions for the 'past events' section of the website.

Also, there are events organised by local groups taking place that have never been sent to me to be advertised on the website or in the magazine (eg Tan Hill Raid). They tend to be advertised just on the local group's Facebook page or by word of mouth. This also means that they are not covered by the club insurance.

Events need to be advertised to let new members know of their existence and I feel that having more information about the individual local groups and showing the fun people have at events would be a great way of getting new members more involved.

Maybe it points to an unintentional undercurrent that event and local group organisers don't realise that new members aren't 'in the know'. The organisers are entrenched in their long-term friendships and associations and as long as the people they know are in the loop they assume that everybody knows the who, what, where and how of their event.

I have not received any updated pdfs of the Registration forms so haven't been able to upload anything to the individual register pages yet.
